We are trying to do this in several ways. Both items in our newsletter this week is a Community response to this need.

The first takes place, Wednesday Mar. 9th @ 8 pm in the GAA Hall. It is open to everyone.

The Second is a talk to be given by Dr. Mary Surlis, in the Church, Sixmilebridge on Mar. 15th @ 7.30pm. Mary is attached to University College Galway. She is a young mother, was a teacher. In recent years she has been running practical programmes in different centres around the West of Ireland. These are intergenerational Programmes i.e. Connecting the generations. She is a wonderful speaker, practical and has a lot to offer parents, teachers and indeed the wider community.

### **Aware Together - Grow Together**

As members of the Sixmilebridge/Kilmurry Community it is important that we are aware of the risks to our Community, and in particular those posed to our youth. An estimate puts the number of children in our Community at 1,400 children; 300Preschool; 600 National School and 500 Teenagers. Children are of paramount importance to any community.

"It takes a village to bring up a child" is a truism worth recalling. The onus is on our Community as a whole to create a healthy, positive and supportive environment for our young people to grow up in. We need to be alert to the real and present dangers to do this.

As a first step to increasing our awareness of the challenges like ours face, an **Information Night will take place on Wed. 9th March at 8pm.** Three guest speakers with expert first hand knowledge will share some of their experiences and advice.
