One of them said 'It is good for us to be here'. Well those of us who were in Kilmurry Church last Tuesday night could say exactly the same thing. A darkened Church lighted only with candle lights - creating a special atmosphere, music and song which helped us to calm, bring healing to our spirits and compose ourselves. Reflections which helped us to nourish the silence - words which echoed into our moods, to be thankful for our Blessings, to cherish the present, live in the now, helped us to trust the future. The spirit will help us to cope, and we do not travel alone. We were reminded of the importance of Silence in the words of a poem by Brendan Kenneally Silence says:

Once I was the heartbeat of the world
But I am an outcast now.
Why do you find it so difficult
To live with me?
I do not ask that you think of me
But of yourself
And what is in you.

And we were reminded of the House of God where we gathered - in Irish tradition called "Teach an Phobail", the house of the people, the place where a community gathers - A Sacred Place and a Sacred Time.
