"Social Media: Challenges for Parents" by Dr. Maureen Griffin.

The event will take place on Tuesday May 21st 7pm -8.30 pm

hosted by Sixmilebridge National School and is offered to Parents / Guardians of children of Primary School Age. Dr. Maureen Griffin, a Forensic Psychologist runs courses for parents and teachers, and has worked with over 700 schools as well as a range of community organisations. The talk will provide information and guidance to parents in safeguarding their children online, offering practical advice on how to protect children when they are online or using mobile devices. Areas covered will include latest developments in young people's usage of social media, social networking sites, social messaging apps; video-streaming sites; mobile device safety; screen time & sleep; grooming and cyber-bullying will also be addressed. Dr Griffin will highlight resources to help parents navigate these areas, providing practical advice and tips for dealing with misuses of technology, followed by questions and answers.

This event is free of charge and is part of the Sixmilebridge G.A.A Club Healthy Club Programme.
