No Pain – No Gain

The story of the two young people on the road to Emmaus is a great one. It's told in the most ordinary of circumstances and simplest of languages. They were talking about all that had happened. They were talking about how this 33 year old revolutionary, who had done so much in such a short time, was betrayed by his own – the crowd with him one day shouting **"Crucify Him"** - another day. Even those closest to Him betrayed Him, turned their backs on Him. They were talking about all that and the cruel way He was dealt with until eventually He died, hanging on a Cross, between two thieves.

And now the young people had just heard that the tomb was **empty.** He is *alive.*

They had expected that he would be the great leader who would lead their country to freedom. But their hopes were dashed.

As they were walking along they were joined by '*this stranger*' who asked them what they were talking about. "Where in the name of God were you" they asked, "these last few days that you didn't hear about everything that happened to a great and good young man?." He walked along with them. They didn't recognise him. Eventually He told them who He was. He joined them for supper. As a result of this meeting they became committed Christians. The question for you and me is – Where do I meet Him - in a meaningful way? We meet Him through Faith, Trust. We meet Him in **His Word**. We meet Him in His Real Presence. We meet Him in Praver. We meet Him in **People** – especially people who carry

We meet Him in **People** – especially people who can crosses and cope.

We meet Him in Silence, Inner peace.

We meet Him in His Gifts to us and in His Creation.

Often enough we might have to suffer a bit, deny ourselves in order to meet Him.
