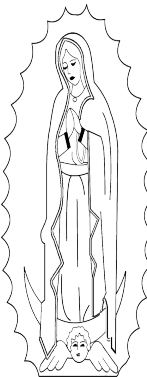

YOUNG PEOPLE SENSE OF THE SACRED

These days and weeks we, as a community are focusing on our young people, in the context of a sense of the Sacred. Last Saturday and next Saturday almost 70 children will have or will receive their First Communion. This means that Jesus in the Eucharist will become part of their lives in a special way. We care for our minds and our bodies in a special way. Or souls and our spirits are nourished by prayer but in a very special way by the reception of the Eucharist.

At the Last Supper, as He sat around the table saying his last farewell to His friends,
He took Bread and took Chalice, He Blessed them. He said **Take these** and then He told them **Do This In Memory of Me.** Generations of Irish people have done this. In spite of persecution and syncism they always regarded the Eucharist as **SACRED** and they also regarded the House of God where Jesus is present, 24 hours a day, as **SACRED.**

In a few weeks time people from all over the world will gather in Dublin to renew their devotion to the Eucharist. We too are called on now to renew our devotion to someone who is so SACRED that the lives of millions of people are shaped by Him and His values.

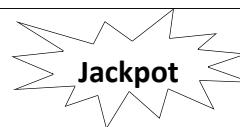
We congratulate them all, and their families. We ask God to Bless them and we pray that we as a community will support them.
