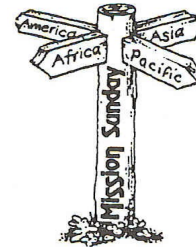

The Mission Sunday poster celebrates "Mission" from the point of view of "Life" and "Family".

Two ideas formed the concept behind the 2014 Mission poster. Theme for 2014 is "That they may have Life", calling on us to reflect on the fulfilment and meaning we experience in living the values of the Gospel.

When we make positive choices of all kinds, the result is a greater experience of life for ourselves and for our neighbour. Secondly, on October 5th Bishops from all over the world have come together for a Synod called by Pope Francis, which will reflect on the challenges facing the modern family in the world. This Synod will close with a celebration of Eucharist on this Sunday which is designated as Mission Sunday 2014.
