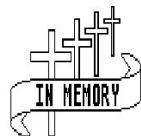

## Ten Commandments For Good Human Relations

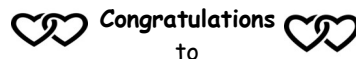
1. Speak to people. There is nothing as nice as a cheerful word or greeting.
