IN NOVEMBER WE REMEMBER

Every day we are reminded of the reality of death - its on the newspapers, local radio; we hear that so and so died, we go to someone else's funeral.

Then we are faced with the death of one of our own. We dread that happening. We get through it. Sometimes we don't know how but we do. And we live with the memory. Recently I read of how a young woman coped with the tragic death of her mother. She wrote; *"I am so often asked how we came to cope with such strength and with no apparent bitterness. I am no saint. I have had my moments of bitterness. I have had my feelings of anger. I found strength to acknowledge them and let them go.*

I thank God that I have not lost my faith despite being put to the test. Some things will never be the same for me and I am very aware that this trauma has changed me in many ways. I still find it hard to pray at times. But I do turn to my God. I find strength to sit in His Presence, just to be and to reflect on what the Son of God suffered, what His mother suffered and I ask them to help me cope. And I love this prayer:"

Every day I need You Lord but this day especially, I need some extra strength to face whatever is to be.

This day more than any day I need to feel you near. To fortify my courage and to overcome my fears. By myself I cannot meet the challenge of the hour. There are times when human creatures need a Higher Power to help them bear what must be borne. And so Dear Lord I pray.

Hold on to my trembling hands and be with me today. And be with me and them this month.
