Parents - Confirmation / First Communion

This coming week we are emphasising in a special way the role of parents in the preparation of their children for Confirmation and First Communion. On Thursday evening 7.30 p.m., Sixmilebridge Church a talk will be given by **Gareth Heagney, Principal, Sixmilebridge School.** He will outline briefly how the children are prepared for these Sacraments. He will outline the importance of values, ethics, awareness of right and wrong in this with emphasis on these two important occasions in their lives. Above all he will stress the vital role of parents in all of this. They can be taught in school, the Parish can make its contribution, but values are caught, not taught and no better place to catch the difference between right and wrong than in the home.
