PLANNING THE FUTURE

Between March and May of this year a listening process took place with nearly 700 people across our Diocese. The major themes from this were recorded. It was an attempt to find out people's experience of local Church and from this identify the key issues regarded as crucial in working towards a living Church into the future.

The main issues identified were:

- Parish and Clusters into the Future
- Partnership in Ministry as the way forward.
- Education in Faith
- Ministry of Young People
- Communication within the Church
- Future financing of the local Church

These are all broken down into sub-headings in a document circulated to Priests, Chairpersons, and Members of Parish Pastoral Councils in the past week.

Gatherings of these groups are now arranged with a view to taking the proposals further.

Education in Faith

Among the suggestions in the document is to do with preparation of children for the Sacraments and the special role of parents in this. The feedback from the Listening Process indicate that the easy availability of Sacraments without any commitment or meaning is something requiring some discussion. The school plays a vital role in preparing children for Confirmation and Communion. We are lucky to have schools and teachers who are dedicated and committed to this. The Parish is expected to play its part. But the most important people of all are Parents. In the next few weeks Children will be enrolled for these Sacraments and Parents will be invited to gatherings outlining their special role. We pray for God's Blessing on all our efforts in preparing our Children at this special time in their lives.
