They will take place at 7.30 p.m in Sixmilebridge Church. We are privileged to have a man from Mary Immaculate College, Dan O'Connell who part wrote the programme to give the three talks.

However, the talks will only be a part of the overall programme for parents. It will include the invitation to form optional Parent Focus Groups. A number of parents will be invited to host simple conversations in their own homes following each session. Cards with two reflective questions, prepared by Dan will be prepared for parents to take away at the end of each talk.

The Meaning to Life Group and Parish Council will be heavily involved in preparing these sessions and the discussion groups in the homes. We will be briefing the wider community on all of this in the next few weeks. We are very excited about this. We believe it could be a real practical way of connecting

Parents - School and Parish.

Parents of Junior and Senior Infants, First Communion and Confirmation Classes will be invited to take part. As well as practical preparation for this programme we will include it in our Masses, Eucharistic Adoration and prayers at home and in the Church.
