## **MISSION**

Pharisees - who were they? The Lord gutted them. He called them hypocrites. They were people who lived by the letter of the law. They were leaders - religious and secular. They went around with long faces. They condemned the world and everyone who stepped out of line. They took the seats of honourat functions and wore fine clothes.

Christ came into their worldand condemnedthem. He went the other way. He reached out to people and especially to people on the margins. He said to the crowd who brought the woman to him -

'let you who have no sin throw the first stone? ..

He left the ninety-nine and went after the one.

So, God loved the world so much He sent His Son to go to the people and tocondemn the world of the Pharisees - the leaders of the time.

There is a lot for us to think about in this.

Over 50 year ago Vatican Council marked a huge shift in the Church. It opened the windows in it to greater interaction with and influence on the real world. But gradually the Church turned inward again.

Pope Francis is calling us back to Vatican 11. He is critical of a church that is 'wrapped up in its own world' and calls on us toreach out to people - wherever they are.

## That is **MISSION** for our time.

Maintaining our own position is not the Church of the future. Where needs are identified the Church must try to respond.
