Power of Prayer

Anyone who has contact with sick people will be constantly reminded of the Power of Prayer. Several times a week I am reminded of this. And if you have been sick yourself you will have no doubt about this. When our backs are to the wall we turn to God - for healing when we are sick, for peace of mind when we are troubled, and in many other times.

This weekend Jesus reminds us 'to pray continually and never lose heart'. The man who was canonised a saint last Sunday. John Henry Newman left us a great legacy of prayers and quotations. He told us: 'Everything that one does honestly, sincerely, with prayer, with advice, must turn to good'. And 'Prayer is a heart to heart conversation'. This man was one of the great academic brains of his time. He was a student in Oxford in one of the two top universities in Britain. He was converted to Catholicism and came to Ireland where he spearheaded the foundation of the Catholic University which came to be known as University College Dublin. He was a great scholar. He wrote 40 books and 1000's of letters on the Spiritual life. He is for sure a saint for our time. He experienced the same struggles and temptations everyone has to face. Through his faith, times of prayer and trust in God he could transform the darkest times into great hope and times of conversion. He wrote the 'Prayers is to spiritual life what the beating of the pulse and the drawing of the breath are to the life of the body: Without God there is a vacuum in our lives and evil fills a vacuum. We want our **Youth Mass** this weekend to be a special step towards faith in God in the lives of our young generation.
