The Sixmilebridge Community Council would like to welcome the Syrian families that have recently arrived in Sixmilebridge. Margaret O'Connell Chairperson of the Parish Pastoral Council and Fr. Harry recently met with representatives of the different agencies responsible for refugee resettlement to hear at first hand how the program was going and how refugees were settling in and to offer a word of welcome on behalf of the community to the families who have come to live among us as part of the Refugee Resettlement Program.

These families were forced to leave their homes in Syria and travel to a refugee camp in the Lebanon - a camp that has over 1 million occupants. They are in fact fleeing war and persecution. They spent a few years in the refugee camp under the protection of the United Nations. Before coming to Ireland they were vetted and screened by both the Dept of Justice and the United Nations. They wanted to come here for their own safety and welfare. These families are ordinary people who have endured the terrors of the war in Syria. They are farmers and fishermen who had no option but to leave their homes and take their children with them. Already the children who started in our national school in September are really settling in well, and even have a few words of Irish but their favourite new thing is hurling. What a difference living in Sixmilebridge has already made to the lives of these children.

The adults attend English classes each morning and the Mens Shed has invited the men to take part in their activities which is wonderful. We are hoping for a similar option for the ladies.

These families have suffered a lot. Therefore anything we can do as a Christian Community to welcome them among us would go a long way to erase those memories.
