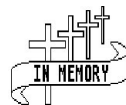

## Love Not Hate

Love, not hate, is central to the Christian Message. To know that the God, we believe in is love, that's reassuring. However, to claim to love Jesus but not to love your neighbour is not love.

Love demands demonstration. Mothers and Fathers do it, husbands and wives do it, brothers and sisters do it, friends do it, carers do it in many heroic and unconditional ways.

Love can be a wonderful experience - we may not call it love but to feel cared for is special.

If you do not feel cared for we as Christians must be careful to think of you, to pray for you, to be there to listen to you - to be simply there for you.

And then love can be a lonely business. Experience teaches us that love involves inevitable risks, separations, conflicts and losses that are only intensified by the depth of our loves. The sense of loss, grieving are deeper when you have loved deeply. And then let our caring be genuine. We need to be careful not to be charitable only when we have useless things to give away. You know the saying ...

*"Do not give broken cups to broken people"*

As acts of charity many people are often inclined to give or donate old items that they no longer have use for. We must never ever take from a person's sense of worth. We must do our best to make 'broken people' feel better by the fact they met us.

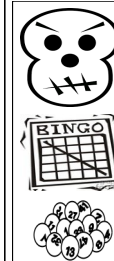
