Parents and Children

We met with the parents of children for Confirmation and First Communion in the past ten days.

We want to take these two key events in their lives very seriously.

We stressed the importance of the day for the children and the families. It's a time for celebration. These days do stay in the memory.

But we put both Sacraments into the context of the 'Christian Community' they are part of in this place. No one loves a child more than their parents. Parents want them to grow up with values – like telling the truth. They want them to grow up with the **WISDOM** to distinguish between right and wrong and the **COURAGE** to say **NO** to the pals or others who might want to lead them astray. We have a Programme in place to help them prepare.

The Parish, School, but above all the Parents are involved in this Programme. As part of this we want all these young people and their parents to **gather** every weekend with the rest of the community, to **connect** with the Power of One they will need in life to nourish their inner strength – to be their own men and women, to be able to stand on their own two feet.

In the next few weeks we will be inviting these young people to enrol for these Sacraments. We would like to invite Parents, the Young People and indeed all of us to reflect on the seriousness of what they are taking on. We are asking the young people to take the *Certificate of Enrolment* and a sheet titled 'What Being Confirmed Means to Me' home with them and to bring them back to present them here at Mass at a formal Ceremony of Enrolment on Sat. 26th November 2011.
