Year of Faith

How often do we hear people say: I wouldn't have been able to get through that without my faith. 'That' meaning the loss of a loved one or a serious illness or some other great set-back in life.

Down through the generations 'the faith' was at the very heart of life for people in Ireland. They believed in God: they had a deep relationship with Him and they nourished the relationship in giving time to Him. For example, we began the day by kneeling at the bedside to say our morning Prayers, including our Morning Offering – 'ever this day be at my side.' At 12 o'clock we paused to say the Angelus and again at 6 p.m. We had the family Rosary, and Night Prayers. So our day was dotted with taking time to acknowledge the Presence of God in our lives. The Mass was central to life – thank God for the week that was and ask His Blessing for the following week. And then there was all the reminders of His Presence – in good times and bad. Thanks be to God. Welcome be the will of God.

Times have changed but most people will have that faith. People will still say: I believe in God. But maybe a lot of other things have got in the way of nourishing it.

So, the Year of Faith. At the beginning of the year, Pope Benedict announced that he would launch a Year of Faith to help Catholics appreciate the gift of Faith, to deepen their relationship with God and to strengthen their commitment to sharing faith with others. Outlining the purpose of the Year of Faith, he spoke of the need to renew our Faith – individuals, families, parishes and schools, in each Diocese, in our country and across the world. In the coming months we will identify ways and means of doing this here in our own parish. In the meantime each one of us might identify some small way of renewing our own faith and that of our families.

It is all about coming to know the love of Jesus Christ for each one of us.
