Re-Discovering What's Lost

In the past week most of the talk was about the matches - 2 All-Irelands. Of the people I met there were 3 who said very interesting things. In all 3 we had conversations about life, what some people have to cope with in life and how a lot of our conversations in Ireland are too much about the negative, about what's wrong. One of the 3, I met, said: *"There are 2 types of people in this world - those that see problems and those that see solutions."* The second said: *"Ask what's possible not what's wrong"*. *"Assume that many others may share your dreams"*. And the 3rd talked about the quality of young people involved in both All-Irelands, their ideals and the sacrifices they have made. They are obviously part of a way of life and culture which could set standards for others. It is not just about sport. It is about respect for one another, it is about courage to stand on one's own two feet; it is about right thinking, or more important thinking about what is right, real values, its about being able to forgive, to rediscover what you have lost and want to recover.

Life can change for all of us if we can discover a right attitude, a positive outlook, a sense of the Sacred, respect for others and appreciate our God-given gifts. We had almost 500 young people for a School Mass on Tuesday last. I visited a number of classes in both schools. We adults have a huge challenge to witness a positive outlook to them in their growing up.
