**Monday 21st September Feast of St Matthew the Apostle**

**Feast of Padre Pio (St. Pius of Pietrelcina)**  
 The Capuchin friar first received the visible wounds of Christ in 1918. For 50 years he carried on his priestly ministry at San Giovanni Rotondo, saying Mass and hearing confessions. Afflicted himself by many physical ailments, he established the Homes for the Relief of Suffering to sustain them spiritually. Padre Pio died in 1968

and was canonised in 2002. Over six million pilgrims visit his shrine each year.

**1c and 2c Coins** The Government has agreed to the rounding of prices involving 1c and 2c coins to the nearest 5c, which leads to the withdrawal of the coins from circulation in the next few months. The Parish/Pastoral Council will hold a **Bucket Collection** at all Masses this weekend for anyone who would like to dispose of these coins. All monies collected will be sent to Refugee Fund.

## International Day of Peace

Each year the International Day of Peace is observed around the world on 21st September. The General Assembly has declared this as a day devoted to strengthening the ideals of peace, both within and among all nations and peoples. The theme of this year's commemoration is *"Partnerships for Peace – Dignity for All"* which aims to highlight the importance of all segments of society to work together to strive for peace. On this day The United Nations invites all nations and people to honour a cessation of hostilities during the Day, and to otherwise commemorate the Day through education and public awareness on issues related to peace. We invite you, in particular on this day to pray for the gift of peace in our world.
