This weekend Fintan Monahan, a priest of the Archdiocese of Tuam,
 becomes our Bishop. Since his appointment was
 announced we have been raying for him. We wish him well. He is
 now our leader.

It's a time to remind ourselves that Leadership is not the
 preserve of those who by accident or design, hold leadership
 positions. We are all called to be leaders and we all have the duty to
 participate in shaping our own lives, or families, our communities.
 It has become obvious in recent years from all that has
 happened that true leadership is about facilitating a society, a Church,
 an organisation to grow from the ground up.

Top-down leadership on its own doesn't work any more.
 Facilitating people to engage is what true leadership is about. True
 leaders have a selfless devotion to service. Pope John XXIII said
"I am the servant of the servants of the people."

True leaders have vision and the ability to make it practical. A new
 vision for a renewed Church, meaning a true Christian Community is
 needed.

But at the end of the day the people who have the greatest
 influence are on the ground - parents, teachers, and indeed all who call
 themselves Christians. There are deep questions now to be asked
