September 27th Saint Vincent de Paul: (1581-1660) from Gascony, France is renowned for compassion, humility and generosity. He was dedicated to serving the poor. He founded the congregation of the Mission (Vincentians) and The Daughters of Charity of Saint Vincent de Paul. Lay Catholic charitable group is also named after him.

September 29th St. Michael, Gabriel, Raphael, Archangels.
