Bereavement

We have had another sad funeral in the past week. We extend our deep sympathy to Pat, Noreen's hyusband, her two children, Ella and Sean, her four sisters, Mary, Ann, Geraldine, Carmel, the Donnellans and all her relatives and friends.

During this month we are remembering the Holy Souls. Last Saturday night we had our Remembrance Mass, for all those who died since this time last year. The Church was packed and we were aware that among the gathering were people feeling the great pain of loss for loved ones. The ceremony itself was a moving experience and touched our own souls.

On Wednesday night the Pastoral Council, at its meeting, again discussed this crucial pastoral issue of support serices for those who are bereaved. Of all the losses faced in life the death of a partner, family member or friend can leave the deepest feelings of loneliness and pain. Whilst grief and loss are a normal part of life there may be times when it feels as if there is no way through. Many people do not require support or counselling to help them deal with their grief. Others do. We are very aware of people in our Community who are grieving. We are also very aware that this is a very sensitive issue and needs to be explored carefully. We

We are carrying out a search now to identify what services are available from outside for individuals, family units, children. At the next meeting of the Pastoral Council the subject of Bereavement will be the main pastoral item on the agenda.
