First Beginnings

At our RTE Mass last Sunday we made the point that if we're to go back to the first beginnings to Jesus Himself for direction in our times we are called on to wonder what God Himself is saying to our world. And on the other hand what's the reality of life for people and families for us now. In our Parish we are all the time trying to find answers to this and that is why we continue to reflect on the Word of God i.e. what is He saying to us now, each day. It's also why we try different initiatives to connect that Word to our inner selves, to one another in our Area Gatherings etc and to our environment.

We also would like to link in to sources of inspiration in helping us to do this. Mary Immaculate College Limerick run a programme to help people study the Word of God as they strive to understand the relevance of that Word for the challenges posed by contemporary society. It aims at equipping participants with tools allowing them to appreciate the nature and depth of the Bible. The course will assist participants to develop their competence for further study of Scripture. These outcomes will not only enrich the life of the individual course participant but will also further enrich the worshipping community to which they belong. This course runs every Wednesday for 12 weeks (7-8 pm) for members of the public and 7-9.30 for students. Details are on the notice board.
