

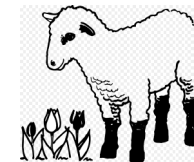

Ordination of Antun Palasic

On Sunday in the Cathedral of SS Peter + Paul in Ennis, Bishop Fintan will ordain Antun Palasic a Priest for service in the Diocese of Killaloe.

Antun is a native of Zagreb in Croatia and lived in Roscrea on coming to Ireland. On September 8th 2021 Antun was ordained a Deacon in the Cathedral in Ennis.

The Ordination Ceremony will take place at 3pm on Sunday and can be watched online at www.ennisparish.com

On Monday 25th April the newly ordained Fr. Antun will celebrate his first Mass of Thanksgiving in the Cathedral at 7.30 pm and after Mass he will give his first blessing.

7. Say 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" on the "Hail Mary" beads.

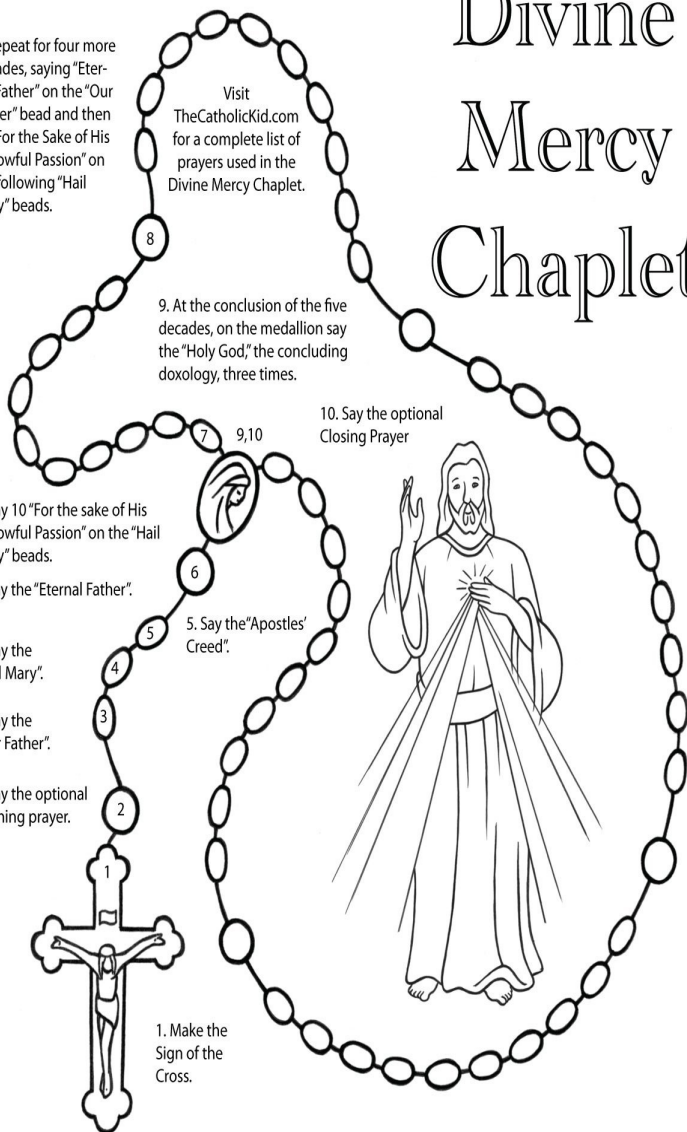
