The money you raised was vital in maintaining and supporting our 60 projects in the areas of


healthcare, education, capacity building, emergency response and vocational training.

- 6,430 tarpaulins and 2,362 solar lights were distributed
- 118 Covid patients were treated in Hope Hospital
