In complying with all Health and Safety guidelines we propose the following will apply......

- ... Each candidate will be accompanied by two adults only, and in the case of Confirmation one adult will be the Sponsor.
- ... Seats will be assigned randomly in a fair manner on arrival at the Church.
- ... Fr. Harry will Administer the Sacraments and do the Readings.
- ... There will be one person playing music during the ceremony.

The above dates and guidelines have been carefully thought through with the safety of everyone in mind.

Toilets will not be in use only in case of emergency.

We ask everyone to wear a face mask in the Church and follow the guidance of stewards on duty.
