

Candle one (purple) represents Hope It is often called the Prophet's candle. Candle two (purple) represents Peace It is often called the Angel's candle. Candle three (pink) represents Joy It is often called the Shepherd's candle. Candle four (purple) represents **Love** It is often called the Bethlehem Candle.

The central candle (white) of the wreath represents the light of Jesus coming into our world
