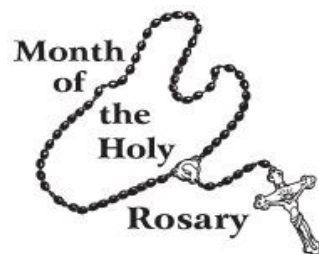

On the 5 decades of a rosary, we pray and meditate on the
corresponding set of 5 Mysteries from the
**Joyful Mysteries, the Sorrowful Mysteries,
The Glorious Mysteries, or the
Luminous Mysteries.**

The Mysteries traditionally adhere to certain days of the week
Monday: Joyful **Tuesday** Sorrowful **Wednesday:** Glorious
Thursday: Luminous **Friday:** Sorrowful **Saturday:** Joyful
Sunday: Glorious
