Bishop Fintan is inviting you to a conversation about the future of our Church

Last month Bishop Fintan gathered the Priests, Ministers of Pastoral Care and representatives of the Parish Pastoral Councils from the parishes in Co Clare to a meeting at the Inn at Dromoland. At this meeting Bishop Fintan began a discussion about possible future structures in the Diocese of Killaloe. In an effort to continue this conversation at grass roots level, Bishop Fintan is now engaging with individual Pastoral Areas across the Diocese in order to hear the views and insights from as many people as possible. He is extending an open invitation to everybody who is interested to engage the question of how we structure ourselves as a Diocese if we are going to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ into the future. With this in mind there will be a meeting on Tuesday 21st March from 7.30 - 9.30 p.m.

As parishioners of the Tradaree Pastoral Area (Parishes of Newmarket-on-Fergus, Shannon + Sixmilebridge) you are invited to come along to engage in more in-depth discussions at local level. The Bishop hopes to glean as much insight as possible before discerning where the Spirit of God is calling us as a Church, and as a Diocese at this time.
