This year **Fr. Harry celebrates 60 years of ordination to the Priesthood.** His Diamond Jubilee.

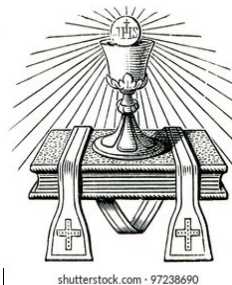
