Unveiling of O'Regan Statue

Innovator, entrepreneur and visionary, the late Dr. Brendan O'Regan will be remembered in his native parish of Sixmilebridge next Monday when a life size statue will be unveiled at a ceremony in The Square which will be attended by members of his family.

The Sixmilebridge Historical Society Committee teamed up with Shannon Chamber of Commerce on the project to publicly acknowledge Dr. O'Regan's inspiration and input in the economic development and prosperity of the Shannon region from the 1950s.

The statue has been designed by Kilbaha sculptor Seamus Connolly and the ceremony, open to all to attend, will get underway at 2 p.m.

Dr. Brendan O'Regan was born in May 1917 in Sixmilebridge, the fourth child of seven of James and Nora O'Regan. His father owned and managed a variety of local businesses including regan's Pub in the village and the Old Ground Hotel in Ennis. He was chairman of Clare County Council from 1906 - 1915.

Brendan attended Sixmilebridge National School before boarding at Blackrock College. He married Rita Barrow in 1950, and they had two sons, Andrew and Declan, and three daughters, Geraldine, Margaret and Carmel.

In 1945, he was appointed catering comptroller at Shannon Airport and he embarked on a series of projects which transformed the Shannon Region, many of which were replicated internationally.

In 1947, he established the world's first duty-free shop at Shannon Airport and four years later set up the Shannon College of Hotel Management. He also pioneered the development of Bunratty Castle as a tourist attraction. In 1959, Brendan established Ireland's first industrial estate, the Shannon Free Zone.

Brendan died peacefully in February 2008, but not before he had left an indelible imprint on the economic prosperity of the Shannon
