First Sunday in Advent



Lord, on this First day of Advent, give us the grace to slow down. Let us travel with the Wise Kings, following the rising Star and seeking advice as we travel.

As the journey begins Lord, we place its destination in your hands and pray giving thanks and praise.

Advent wreaths are circular, representing God's infinite and eternal love. The candles on the Advent wreath symbolise

Hope, Love, Joy and Peace - Jesus

Candle one (purple) represents Hope
It is often called the Prophet's candle.
Candle two (purple) represents Peace
It is often called the Angel's candle.
Candle three (pink) represents Joy
It is often called the Shepherd's candle.
Candle four (purple) represents Love
It is often called the Bethlehem Candle.
The central candle (white) of the wreath represents the light of Jesus coming into our world.
