Brigid, give us energy.

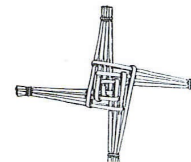
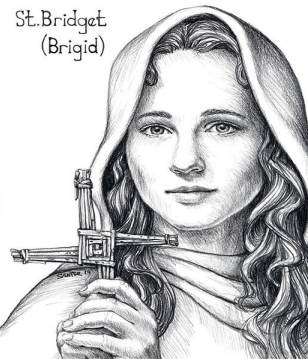
You lit a fire that never quenched.
