Holy Week

Palm Sunday reminds us of the glory days of life, the happy days, the days when we are supported and affirmed.

Monday and Tuesday can remind us of the ordinariness of life.

On **Monday night** we have the **Tradaree Easter Reconciliation** in St. Finnachta's Church, Sixmilebridge at 7.30 p.m.

Spy Wednesday when we have felt betrayed or let down by family friends, or our own failings.

Holy Thursday reminds us of the togetherness that we enjoy in life. The Eucharist that Christ shared with His disciples represents the Communion He shares with us.

Good Friday represents all that is dark and evil in life.

Holy Saturday represents, for us, the emptiness of life on occasions.

Easter Sunday we come to the Resurrection when we are reminded there is a life after death.

Holy Week is a special week as we try to participate in some reminders of the suffering it took to found Christianity.
