Dear Lord,

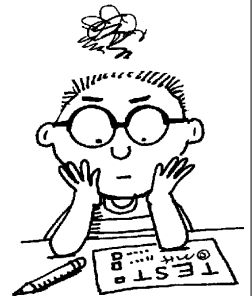
As I take this exam, I thank you that my value is not based on my performance,
