Shannon Blood Donation Clinic

With many people away on holidays and busy with seasonal activities, clinic attendance often declines, making it challenging to maintain the critical blood supplies needed by Irish Hospitals.

This year, the challenge is even greater as hospitals across Ireland are requiring 6% more blood than this time last year. To meet this increased demand we need another 15,000 new blood donors come forward and give blood this year.

We are calling on the community to support our Blood Donation Clinic at the Shannon Oakwood Hotel on Tuesday 13th and Wednesday 14th August from 4pm – 7.20pm.

New donors are welcome and just one contribution can make a difference.
