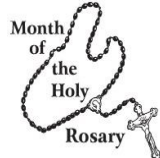

In Ireland, *Missio Ireland* is tasked with organising the Mission Sunday Collection. *Missio Ireland* is the Pope's official charity for overseas missions.

All offerings made on behalf of World Mission Sunday become part of the Holy Father's Universal Solidarity Fund. This Fund supports missionary activities in over 1,150 young dioceses; mostly in Africa, Asia, and Latin America.

For Mission Sunday 2024, Pope Francis has chosen the theme **'Go and invite everyone to the Banquet'**. Mission, he said, is a tireless going out to all men and women, in order to invite them to encounter God.
