The Advent Wreath



Advent wreaths are circular, representing God's infinite and eternal love. The candles on the Advent wreath symbolise

Hope, Love, Joy and Peace

Candle one (purple) represents **Hope**

It is often called the Prophets' candle.

Candle two (purple) represents **Peace**

It is often called the Angels' candle.

Candle three (pink) represents **Joy**

It is often called the Shepherds' candle.

Candle four (purple) represents **Love**

It is often called the Bethlehem Candle.

On Christmas Eve we light the (White) Candle representing **Christ**
