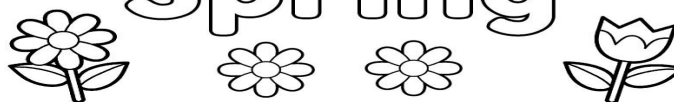
Apostolic Work - Annual Display
