Venerable Matt Talbot Relics This year on the 7th June Matt Talbot who overcame addiction with the help of God through prayer and sacrifice will be 100 years dead. The cause for his Canonisation has already begun. On this Monday evening The Order of the Knights of St Columbanus will be bringing the Relics of Matt Talbot to the 7.30pm Mass in Ennis Cathedral for the monthly Mass of the Matt Talbot Prayer Society Praying for those suffering from addiction and their families.

The Annual Matt Talbot Novena will return on Ash Wednesday, 5th March 2025 at 7:00PM in Tulla Church with Mass and Benediction. Bishop Fintan Monahan will open the Novena.
