The true mystery of the Trinity is that our God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit love us all deeply and treat us with great tenderness and mercy.

Sacred Heart Novena - 19th - 27th June

First Day (19 June) Theme - A Heart that Attracts Praver: Lord Jesus, great crowds were attracted to you. Something about you made them want to be with you. Help me always to experience that attraction and to find you in every situation.

Second Day (20 June) Theme - A Heart that Welcomes Prayer: Jesus, I know that you have a warm welcome for everyone. You want to meet me as I am, warts and all. So here I am, Lord. It's good to be here.

Third Day (21 June) Theme - A Heart that Forgives Praver: Loving Jesus, you came among us to remove the barriers that lead us away from you. Teach me to forgive others in the same open-hearted way you forgive me.

Fourth Day (22 June) Theme - An Ever-Present Heart Prayer: Lord, sometimes it can be hard to find you. There are times when you seem to be asleep. Lord, help me to believe deeply that you are never absent, that every storm will pass.

Fifth Day (23 June) Theme - A Prayerful Heart Prayer: Lord Jesus, you sought out places to be alone with your Father. Help me to find an opportunity each day to spend even a short time in the Father's Presence.

Sixth Day (24 June) Theme - A Heart for Service Prayer: Lord Jesus, you came among us as one who serves. Help me to live with your values and in imitation of your life.

Seventh Day (25 June) Theme - A Generous Heart Prayer: Lord Jesus, teach me to be grateful for all the good things I have received from you, and to imitate you in being generous in sharing them with others.

Eighth Day (26 June) Theme - A Broken Heart Prayer: Help me, Lord, to place my trust in the gift of life that flows from vour wounded heart.

Ninth Day (27 June) Theme - A Victorious Heart Prayer: Sacred Heart of Jesus, I ask you to deepen in me the graces of this novena. Show me how to pass on to others the consolation you so generously offer me.
