

Broadford based Recruitment Executive Alex O'Connor of the Irish Blood Transfusion Service said: "Every Christmas we see a gap in donations, but the need for blood in our hospitals does not pause. We are asking anyone who is able to give blood in Clare to please come forward — taking under an hour can make a real difference for patients."
