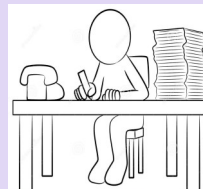

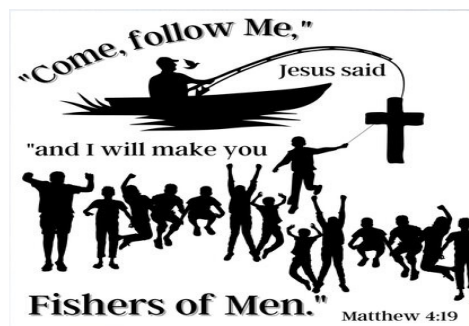

May they Rest in Peace.</p>	<p>Newmarket –on-Fergus St Conaire’s Feast Day: 28th January Carrigerry. There is a custom of leaving the crib up in Carrigerry church until the feast day of St Conaire. She is a significant figure in Irish history, recognized as the patron saint of the parish church in Carrigerry. She was a nun from West Cork who visited her cousin at a monastery on Scattery Island, where she was initially denied ashore due to her gender.
